Re: Asbestos Management Plan

In compliance with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), the Keystone School District has performed inspections of our school buildings for asbestos-containing materials. The inspection findings and Asbestos Management Plans are on file in each school's main office.

The EPA also requires us to perform re-inspections of the asbestos materials every three years. Accredited asbestos inspectors will perform these inspections. An accredited management planner will review the results of the re-inspections and recommend actions we should take to safely manage all asbestos materials in our buildings.

All asbestos materials in the schools are in good condition and we will continue to manage them in place, as recommended by the accredited management planner. Our buildings are formally inspected by maintenance staff every six (6) months to determine any changes in the condition of identified asbestos-containing building materials. In addition to this formal surveillance, all regular maintenance personnel have been trained to continuously observe the asbestos-containing materials in District facilities and report anything unusual that pertains to those materials immediately to the Asbestos Program Manager for follow up. This is all a part of continuing efforts to maintain a safe environment for occupants.

The formal Asbestos Management Plan(s) are available for inspection by any interested individual by appointment made through Mr. Bill Baughman, Supervisor of Buildings and Grounds. He can be reached at 797-1251 ext. 116.

We remind you that this notification is required by law and should not be construed to indicate the existence of any hazardous conditions in our school buildings.
