

July Athletic Council Meeting Minutes

Members present: Mr. Barrett, Mr. Beary, Mr. Slagle, Mr. McCormick, Mr. Irwin, Mr. Best, and Mrs. McNaughton

1. Discussed the likelihood that there would be more volunteer coaches submitting letters and paperwork for the football program.
2. The soccer program for the 2022-2023 season was discussed. The junior high program will move forward with 20 players committed to playing. Varsity Girls' Soccer will continue with 13 players; there is anticipation that more girls will join the team. Varsity Boy's Soccer currently has 10 players committed. Mr. Irwin is going to reach out to the coach to get the 10 players to encourage others to join the team. Mr. Irwin will also look for the possibility of a co-cop for the Boys' Team. A decision will be made in August to determine if the boys will have a season. Mr. Irwin is going to contact the other schools to let them know there is a possibility that we may not have a team for the 2022-2023 season since the game schedule has already been set.
3. Currently, CHAMPs has not found us an athletic trainer. CHAMPs has encouraged us to offer more money in order to secure an athletic trainer. This will be a recommendation made to the schoolboard. Mr. Best has reached out to Penn Highlands and Meadville Medical Center as well, but has not heard back from these organizations. Mr. Best is also going to investigate regulations for who can administer impact testing – Mr. Irwin confirmed that according to PIAA regulations, schools are not mandated to conduct impact testing.
