A. Required exit criteria
☐ Score of BASIC on the annual Pennsylvania System of School Assessment
(PSSA) (or Pennsylvania Alternative State Assessment (PASA) if necessary)
☐ Score of 5.0 on a Tier C ACCESS for ELLs assessment
B. Additional criteria
☐ Final grade of C or better in core subject areas (Math, Language Arts, Science,
Social Studies)
☐ Scores on a district-level assessments that are comparable to the BASIC
performance level on the PSSA
