 - This sale may also offset graduation costs should the sale top the class super goal.
 - You earn 30% of your total sales and may also win cash prizes to offset the trip cost.
 - Start early and let friends, relatives, and community members know you will be selling the magazines before it begins.

Senior Class Trip to Washington D.C. [Tentative dates: November 11-15]

- COST: - Estimating \$600-\$650 (last year \$605)
 - The final cost will be calculated as soon as possible next school year.
 - Deposit of \$200 to reserve a spot on the trip will be due in mid-September.
 - The trip is all-inclusive - all meals/admissions are included in the price of the trip.
 - PLEASE NOTE - There will be several payment dates set. ALL trip costs must be paid before the trip leaves. NO EXCEPTIONS!
 - Payments/deposits are NON-REFUNDABLE. The only fundraiser for this trip is the Magazine Sale.
 - Plan ahead financially for this trip. If able, set money aside if you work this summer to help make these payments easier in the fall!
- RESERVATION FORMS AND FIRST DEPOSIT of \$200 will be due in mid-September. Exact date will be given at the first class meeting.
- TRIP MEETING
 - A mandatory meeting for all seniors going on the trip and one parent will be held approximately one week before the trip. When the date is announced, mark it on your calendar and make sure you and a parent/guardian are there.
 - You cannot go if you miss this meeting.

- TRIP ELIGIBILITY
 - All seniors are eligible for this trip unless you are disqualified by virtue of the demerit system outlined in the student handbook

Class Shirts/Hoodies (optional)

- These shirts are also used for the Senior Class photo in late-April.
- Custom design by your class officers with all class names.
 - Three styles available (short and long sleeved T; hoodie)
 - Last year's costs - \$17 - \$20 - \$27

Graduation Announcements (optional)

- Order and payment due in December or January
- Cost varies with packages and individual purchases available (approx. \$1.00 per announcement)

Senior Project Presentation

- All seniors will present a culminating project in American Government class. Details given in American Government and English classes.

Pittsburgh Pirates Game April/May

- Seniors selling magazines may qualify to attend a DAYTIME Pirate game.
 - Students reaching a predetermined sales goal (goal will be given at the August 31 meeting) receive a free ticket to this game.
