ATTENTION Parents/Guardians of 11th Graders: Letters were mailed home in April with information about the new immunization requirements that begin in August 2017. The Pennsylvania Department of Health has changed the school immunization regulations and **all students entering 12th grade for the 2017-18 school year are required to obtain a 2nd dose of Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine (MCV), unless the first dose was given on or after the age of 16.** Please submit proof of this immunization by August 15, 2017.

***Please note that there is NO grace period with this new regulation. If your child does not have this immunization completed within the first 5 days of the start of school, he/she will NOT be permitted to attend school until this immunization is complete or a written and signed plan is provided to the school by your physician. If you have any questions, please contact the nurse's office.

Elementary School

ATTENTION Parents/Guardians of 6th Graders: Letters were mailed home in April with information about the immunization requirements for students entering 7th grade. The Pennsylvania Department of Health requires that **all students entering 7th grade obtain one dose of Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine (MCV) and one dose of tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis (Tdap) if five years have lapsed since the last tetanus immunization.** Please submit proof of these immunizations by August 15, 2017. **Please note that there is NO grace period with this regulation. If your child does not have these immunizations completed within the first 5 days of the start of school, he/she will NOT be permitted to attend school until complete or a written and signed plan is provided to the school by your physician. If you have any questions, please contact the nurse's office.

ATTENTION Parents/Guardians of students entering Kindergarten for the 2017-18 school year: A record of all required immunizations is due in the nurse's office by August 15, 2017. With the new regulations, The Pennsylvania Department of Health has NO grace period. If your child does not have the required immunizations within the first 5 days of school, he/she will NOT be permitted to attend school until the immunizations are complete or a written and signed plan is provided to the school by your physician.
