CLASS PICTURE / INDIVIDUAL CAP AND GOWN PHOTOS

- **Thursday, April 11, 7:45 a.m.**, is cap and gown picture day for the senior class. Be here! There is no make-up date for this.
- All seniors will be photographed. You are not required to purchase any pictures.
- Pictures will include:
 - Full class photo in the form of a “19.” The class officers will let you know what to wear for this photo. Usually casual attire and/or class shirts (or a matching color). This photo could happen on the football field or bleachers.
 - Honors groups cap and gown photos. After the “19” photo, you will have time to change into your cap and gown, shoes, and the clothes you will wear underneath (see the back of this sheet for required commencement attire). Honors pictures will be based on your overall GPA following the 3rd grading period. Final honor designation may change during commencement practice based on Quarter 4 grades.
 - Individual cap and gown photos.
 - Full group cap and gown photo.
 - The yearbook staff may request additional photos. Be attentive to the directions of your class officers regarding what to wear.
- You do not have to place your order for pictures the day of the pictures. Instead, the company will either send order forms home with the students on the day of the pictures or will send order forms to students at the school with proofs of their photos a few weeks later. This includes full group, honor group, and individual photos.

CAP AND GOWN INFORMATION

- Your caps and gowns have been ordered! There is no cost to you for caps and gowns. You will receive these during a class meeting in March.
- National Honor Society stoles will be given to NHS members to wear for pictures and commencement. They will be returned to Mr. Kifer following commencement.
- Honors cords will be available for photos as well. These are purchased by the class account and are yours to keep following commencement.

UPCOMING EXPENSES

The end of the year brings with it various costs for you and your family. Here are some costs that you can plan for as the school year comes to a close.

- **Clothing Required for Pictures and Commencement** – Be aware of possible costs involved in securing proper attire for pictures and commencement. Under the supplied gown purchased by the School District, gentlemen should wear **dark slacks** and **dark dress shoes** with **dark socks** and a **white collared shirt** and **long necktie**. Girls should wear **white shoes**, a **light colored skirt** and **blouse** or a **light colored dress**. Plan now for these items, as you will need them for the **April 11** photos!
- **Cap and Gown Pictures – Individual / Honors / Full Class** – No money will be due the day of pictures. Students will receive order information either the day of pictures or in the weeks following pictures. All students will be photographed, even if not purchasing pictures.
- **Pirates Game** – For those who qualify, the Class of 2019 funds cover the ticket and transportation for this game. However, any food or souvenirs purchased are at the expense of the student.
- **Senior Banquet** – This catered meal and awards ceremony is tentatively scheduled for Thursday, May 30. Keystone School District covers the cost of the graduating senior. However, all others attending must pay for a meal. Although a final cost has not yet been set, the price is usually \$11 to \$14 per person.
- **Commencement Flowers** – Graduating seniors will wear the class flower as part of the attire for commencement. This flower will likely be purchased with the Class of 2019 funds. Additional flowers may be purchased at the expense of the student (usually around \$5 to \$8 per flower). Order forms will be available in late April for these flowers.
- **Class Reunion Start Up Money** - \$5.00 – More information later on how to pay.
- **Indebtedness** – All indebtedness to the school must be settled or you cannot participate in commencement practice or commencement. This must be done on or before your last day of classes.

FINAL NOTES

- Be sure that the administration will be alert to student behavior as the school year draws to a close. Students will face consequences for inappropriate behavior. Seniors behaving badly or instigating bad behavior in others could risk being denied the privilege of participation in commencement.
- Keep your grades up! Pay close attention to your class work, especially any courses that you are in danger of failing for the year. Do not create a stressful May for yourself where you are in danger of not graduating.
